PRESS NOTE

FOR ATTENTION OF PENSION DISBURSING AUTHORITIES

Haryana Government pensioners/family pensioners have pointed out certain difficulties being faced for claiming additional pension/family pension allowed by the State Government at the age of 80/85/90/95/100 years as follows in the absence of Date of Birth not mentioned in the Pension/Family Pension Payment Orders:-

Age in years of pensioner/family pensioner	Additional quantum of pension/family pension with effect from 1.1.2006
80 - 85	20% of revised basic pension/family pension
85 - 90	30% of revised basic pension/family pension
90 - 95	40% of revised basic pension/family pension
95 - 100	50% of revised basic pension/family pension
100 or more	100% of revised basic pension/family pension

Dearness Relief shall also be admissible on the additional quantum of pension as per orders issued from time to time.

The additional quantum would be admissible from the first day of the month in which his date of birth falls. For this purpose the procedure outlined in Finance Department letter dated 20th October, 2009 requiring submission of four copies of PAN Card or Matriculation Certificate or Passport or Driving License containing Date of Birth duly attested by Gazetted Officer/MLA may be adopted to settle such claims.

In case the pensioner/family pensioner is unable to submit any of the documents mentioned above but claims additional pension based on some other documentary evidence, such cases will be submitted to the Administrative Departments. If the Administrative Department is satisfied about the claim of the pensioner/family pensioner, it will authorize additional pension/family pension accordingly. The decision of the Administrative Department in this regard will be final.
